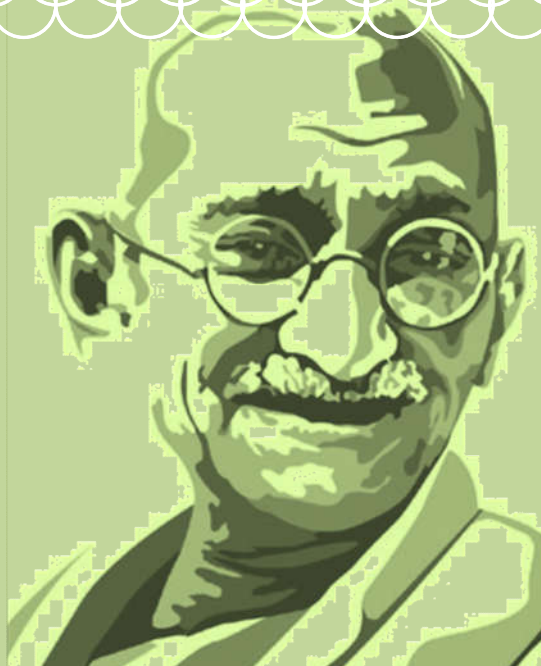

7. Students should be inculcated with desirable values of culture
8. Moral virtues like Righteousness, Integrity, Self-Restraint, Purity of Character should be cultivated
9. Self-realisation should be the ultimate goal of education.
